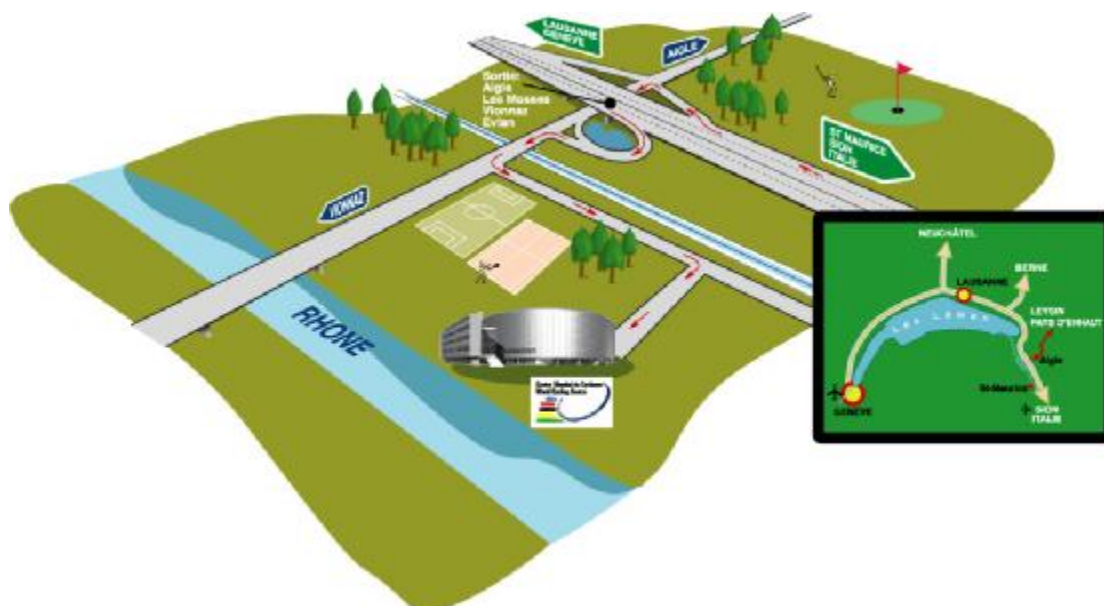

- Cantonal highway in the direction of "Evian/Noville". 100 m after the motorway exit (before the Rhône), take the left-hand lane signed "zone industrielle / Aigle / Service des Automobiles" (Industrial estate / Aigle / Automobile Service). After 250 m turn right (ch. de la Mêlée).

MEALS

PAYMENT

You will receive an invoice (registration charge, meals and accommodation) on receipt of your registration.

Your final registration will be confirmed when your country has paid the amount due and only countries which have made the appropriate payments will receive an accreditation and be authorized to take part in the competitions. No payment will be accepted on site.

After your definitive registration, in case of cancellation on your part until 3 weeks before the beginning of the competitions, the totality of the committed amount per person will be reimbursed. Passed this deadline, no refund will be granted.

TRANSPORT

Geneva International Airport. No shuttle service will be organised from the airport or from the different hotels. Each delegation must arrange its own transport for the duration of the championships. However, we have negotiated special rates with the Europcar car hire agency for the duration of the championships. A 30% discount on the standard charge will be granted to you from any point in Switzerland and for all categories of vehicle.

Track:

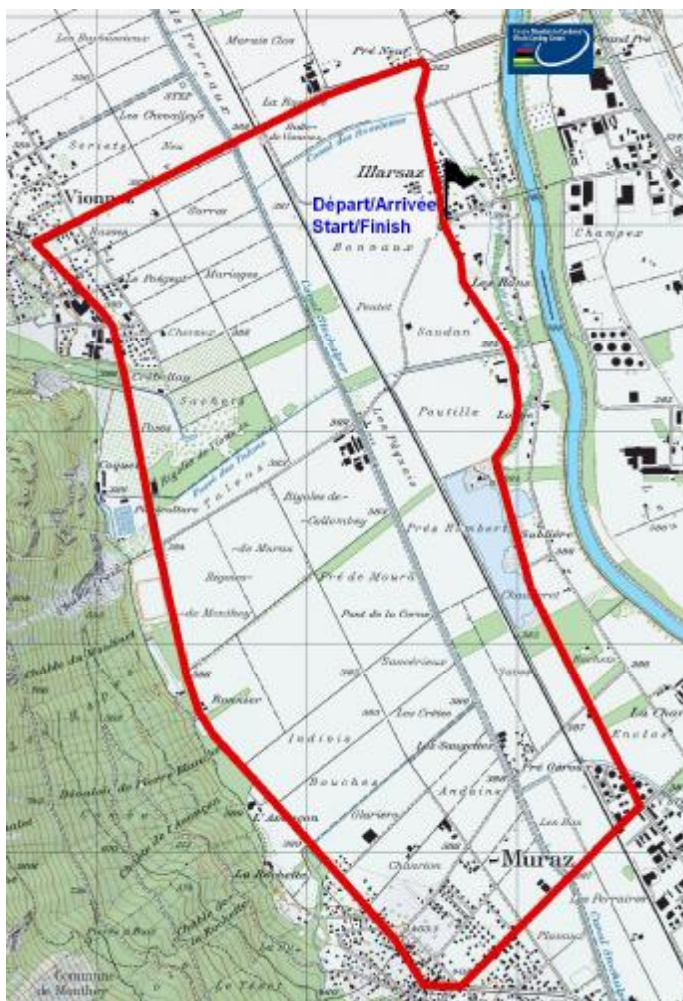
Track competitions will be held in the velodrome at the World Cycling Centre in Aigle – www.cmc-aigle.ch.

- Technical description:
- Wooden covered track
 - Length: 200 m.
 - Width: 6.65 m.
 - Minimum slope: 13.6° on the straight
 - Max slope: 46.7° on the bends

Road:

The in line road competitions will be held close to the World Cycling Centre in Aigle.

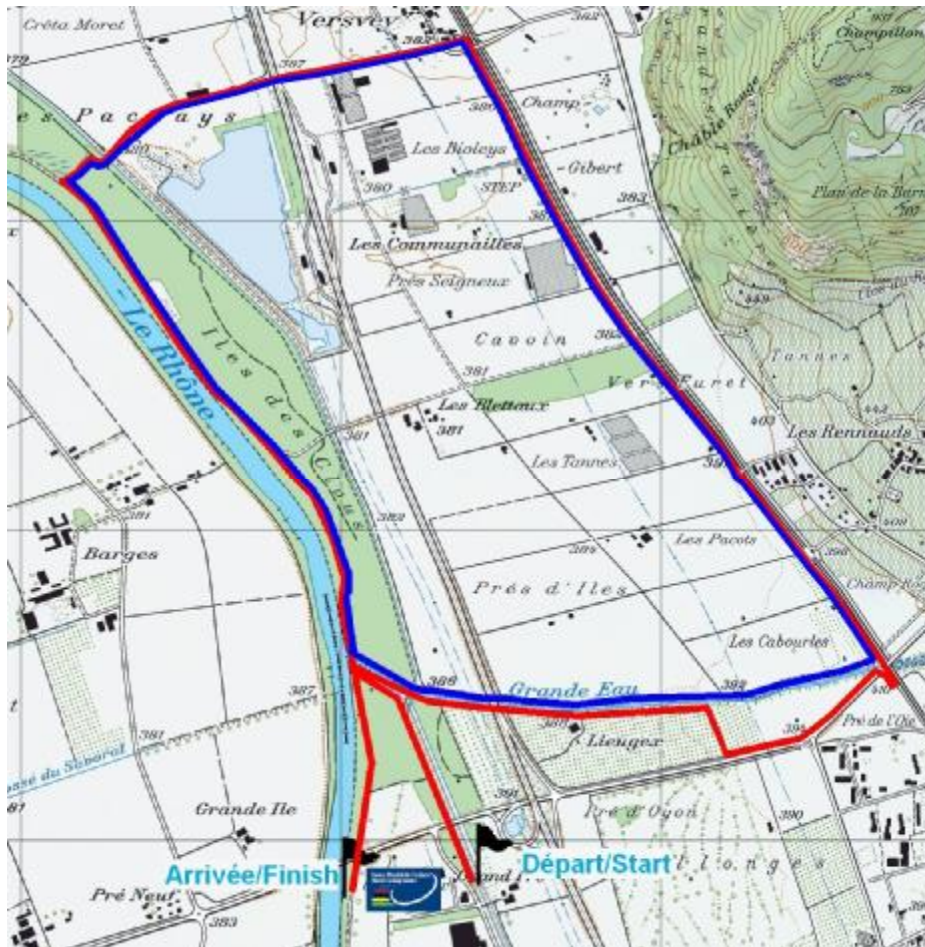
- Technical description:
- Circuit: 11.6 km to be covered several times depending on the class to which the rider belongs
 - Circuit altitude difference: none



Time Trials:

The time trial competitions will be held close to the World Cycling Centre in Aigle.

- Technical description:
- Red circuit: 9.4 km
 - Blue circuit: 7.4 km to be covered several times depending on the class to which the rider belongs
 - Altitude difference of the circuit: none



The central point of all the track and road competitions will be the World Cycling Centre in Aigle. Each nation will be allocated a cabin to store its equipment. Cloakrooms will also be available to the riders for the duration of the championships.

The city of Aigle is very well served by train. However, access to the World Cycling Centre requires a private vehicle.
